CHAPTER 189.

AN ACT amending sub-chapter 11, of chapter 159, laws of 1885, entitled "an act to revise, codify and amend chapter 278, of the laws of 1874, entitled, "an act to incorporate the city of Shawano, and the several acts amendatory thereof."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby enacted a new section to sub-chapter 11, of chapter 159, laws of 1885, to be known as section 2a, which shall read as follows: Section 2a. One-half of all moneys derived from licenses, granted by the common council of said city for the sale of intoxicating liquors, shall be immediately paid by the city treasurer to the treasurer of the school district of the city of Shawano, and be applied to the support of the common schools of said city, and the balance of such license money shall be kept separate from the other money by such city treasurer and be applied to defraying the expense of the support of the poor of said city, so far as necessary for that purpose, and the residue remaining in the hands of such treasurer at the expiration of the year for which such licenses are paid, shall be applied to the support of the common schools of said city and shall be by such city treasurer paid to the school district treasurer of the school district of the city of Shawano, to be used for the support of the common schools of said city.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
