CHAPTER 194.

AN ACT to provide for the payment of the officiating chaplain of the senate.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation to pay chaplain of senate.

SECTION 1, The sum of one hundred and fifty dollars in full, is hereby authorized to be paid to Rev. H. Stone Richardson for his services as chaplain of the senate, during the session of the legislature for the year 1889.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, a sufficient sum to carry out the provisions of this act.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved March 28, 1859.
