city officers of said city, and for the purpose of continuing the construction of such sewers as shall or may be included in any amendments to or changes of the said plans during the years 1889 and 1890.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 8, 1889.

CHAPTER 303.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the city of Milwaukee, and to fix the salary of the city clerk of said city.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amend charter of Milwaukee. Clerk's salary.

Amending ch. 184, laws of 1874.

SECTION 1. The salary of the city clerk of the city of Milwaukee is hereby fixed at the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars per annum. SECTION 2. This act is amendatory of the char-

ter of the city of Milwaukee, being chapter 184, of the laws of 1874, and the various laws amendatory thereof, and any of the provisions thereof, inconsistent, or in conflict with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 8, 1889.
