The question, when submitted to the votes, shall be upon a separate ballot, and the ballots on the license question shall be in the following form: Those in favor, "For license;" those against, "No license;" and shall be deposited in a separate ballot box provided for that purpose, and whenever a majority of the voters voting thereon shall declare by their votes as aforesaid in favor of license, then the common council shall grant license according to the provisions of the laws of the state of Wisconsin on that subject; and in case the majority of the voters voting thereon should declare for no license as aforesaid, then, and in every such case, the common council shall have no power or authority to grant license or druggists' permits for the sale of intoxicating liquors and drinks in said city.

SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed. Repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 357.

AN ACT to amend chapter 409, of the laws of 1887, entitled, "an act to revise, consolidate and amend the act incorporating the city of Berlin, and the several acts amendatory thereof."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section number 158, of chapter 409, of the laws of 1887, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof, the following words: And provided, further, that any member of said common council may demand the call of the yeas and nays on any vote to be taken by said council, and upon such demand being made, the clerk shall call the Amendment to chapter 409, laws of 1887.

CHAPTER 358.

AN ACT to amend chapter 322, of the laws of 1885, entitled, "an act to incorporate the city of Lake Geneva," and acts amendatory thereof.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2, of chapter 1, of said act to incorporate the city of Lake Geneva, is hereby amended so as to read as follows, to-wit: From and after the first day of May, A. D. 1889, all of the territory in the county of Walworth and state of Wisconsin, included within the following boundaries, shall constitute the city of Lake Geneva, that is to say: Commencing at the southeast corner of town two north, range seventeen east, in said county, and running thence north on the east line of said town, forty chains to the quarter post therein, thence east four hundred and sixty-six and sixty-nine hundredths feet on the east and west quarter line of section thirty-one, in town two north, range eighteen east, in said county, thence north four hundred and sixty-six and sixty nine hundredths feet, thence west four hundred and sixty-six and sixty-nine hundredths feet to the aforesaid east line of said town two north, range seventeen east, thence north on said town line to the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of section twenty-five in said town, thence west on the east and
