CHAPTER 513.

AN ACT to provide for the expenses of the joint select committee appointed under joint resolution No. 12, A.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

mittee.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, one hundred thirty-three dollars and eighty cents to William Foster for services as stenographer at the sessions of the joint committee appointed under joint resolution No. 12, A, and twenty-one dollars seventy-five cents to James Fielding for services in serving subpoenas; also a sufficient sum of money to pay fees, and mileage to the several witnesses examined by said committee.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be force from and after its passage and publication.
