## CHAPTER 87.

# AN ACT to declare a portion of Dell river or Dell creek, in Sauk county, navigable.

#### The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Declaring portion of Dell creek, Sauk county, navigable.

SECTION 1. That portion of the waters of Dell river, or Dell creek, in Sauk county, above the dam, located on the northeast quarter of section twenty-one, township number thirteen north, range six east, and running through sections number twenty-one, twenty, twenty-nine, thirty and thirty-one of said township number thirteen north, range six east, and section number thirty-six in township number thirteen north, range five east, are hereby declared navigable, and a public highway, including all waters known as "Mirror lake."

Certain rights not impaired. 1

SECTION 2. This act shall not be construed to in any manner impair the right to maintain the dams now existing on said stream mentioned in section 1.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
