## JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1.

Instructing the superintendent of public property to furnish certain books for the use of the legislature.

Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring: That the superintendent of public property be and is hereby instructed to provide and furnish to each member of the legislature, and to the elective officers thereof, one copy each of the revised statutes of Wisconsin for 1878, and of the laws of 1878, 1879, 1880, 1881, 1882, 1883, 1885 and 1887, and of the senate and assembly journals for 1837 and of the blue book 1837, Berryman's supplement, also two copies each of the above for the judiciary committee of each house, and one of each of the above for each other committee room.

That the state librarian be and he is hereby instructed to furnish the judiciary of each house with a set of Wisconsin supreme court reports, the latest digest thereof and Berryman's supplement to the revised statutes. All of the supreme court reports, digest and supplement to be returned to their proper custodians at the close of the session.
