CHAPTER 140.

AN ACT to authorize O. D. Van Dusen, Josiah Arnold and Fred Arnold, their associates, heirs and assigns, to build and maintain a dam across the south fork of Flambeau river, in Price county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

O. D. Van Dusen, et al., authorized to build dam across south fork Flambeau river.

Shute or slide.

SECTION 1. O. D. Van Dusen, Josiah Arnold and Fred Arnold, their associates, heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized to build and maintain a dam across the south fork of the Flambeau river, on lot eight, in section six, in township thirty-nine north, of range one east, Price county, said dam not to exceed eleven feet in height from the bottom of the stream.

SECTION 2. The said O. D. Van Dusen, Josiah Arnold and Fred Arnold, their associates, heirs and assigns, shall build and maintain a shute or slide in said dam of not less than forty feet in width, for the running of logs and timber over the same, which shute or slide shall be kept open at all times when said river is at a driving stage, and there are logs or timber to be run over said dam.

SECTION 3. The right to alter, amend or repeal this act is hereby reserved.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
