CHAPTER 142.

AN ACT to authorize H. C. Payne, his heirs, associates or assigns, to build and maintain a dam across the Yellow river, at or near the town of Babcock, Wood county, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Henry C. Payne, his heirs, associates or assigns, are hereby authorized to construct, maintain and keep a dam not exceeding eight feet in height above low water, across the Yellow river, at or near the town of Babcock, in township twenty-one north, of range three east, Wood county, Wisconsin. Said dam to be constructed and maintained for manufacturing purposes; provided, that said dam shall be constructed so that it will not interfere with the free passage of logs, or with the rights of any person or corporation heretofore acquired.

SECTION 2. The right to alter, amend or repeal this act is hereby reserved.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
