## CHAPTER 15.

AN ACT to authorize the justice of the peace elected in the Third ward of the city of Two Rivers, to keep his office in the Second ward of said city.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Justice of the peace elected in third ward may keep his office and perform duties in the second ward. SECTION 1. The justice of the peace, elected in the Third ward of the city of Two Rivers, may keep his office and perform all the duties pertaining thereto, in the Second ward of said city, as fully as he does now in the ward where he is elected.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved March 4, 1891.
