CHAPTER 174.

AN ACT to amend section 904, of chapter 40, of the revised statutes of 1878, entitled, "Of villages."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Streets and
alleys, how
discontinued.

SECTION 1. Section 904, of the revised statutes of 1878, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Upon petition in writing of the owners of lots on, or land on any street or alley in such village, the board of trustees may discontinue such street or alley, or any part thereof; provided, that all the owners of lots or land on the portion of such street or alley proposed to be vacated and two-thirds of the owners of lots or land on the remainder of such street or alley, shall sign such petition, and not otherwise. At least one week before acting on such petition, the board of trustees shall cause a written or printed notice to be posted in three public places in such village, stating when the petition will be acted upon and what street or alley or part thereof is proposed to be vacated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
