CHAPTER 323.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the city of Waupaca.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 4 and 6, of chapter 6, as enter 246, laws of acted under chapter 246, of the laws of 1887, enter 1887. titled "An act to amend the charter of the city Waupaca," is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 4. Sidewalks shall be con-construction structed upon the proper grade of any street in such city, of such width and in such manner, and of such materials and in such time as the common council by ordinance shall direct, by the owner or owners of any lot or piece of ground in front of which such sidewalk shall be ordered, and the same shall thereafter be maintained by such city. Section 6. Whenever a sidewalk or Repair of sidegutter shall be out of repair and shall be dangerous to public safety or travel, it shall be the duty of the street commissioner to repair the same immediately at the expense of such city.

SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts conflicting Repealing clause.

herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 20, 1891.
