## CHAPTER 328.

AN ACT amending the charter of the city of Milwaukee, and providing for the appointment of assistant assessors therein.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appointment of assistant assessors.

Section 1. It shall be lawful for the common council of the city of Milwaukee, to provide by resolution or ordinance, either for extra compensation or assistants to those assessors, whose wards or districts have been enlarged and whose labor has been increased by annexation of additional territory to the city. Such assistants, if needed, shall be appointed in the same manner as assessors, and shall be residents of the respective wards for which they are appointed. shall enter upon their duties under the direction of the tax commissioner, for such time and at such compensation as the common council shall determine. They shall take the oath required of city officers and shall have the same authority under the law as regular assessors. Where an assessor and an assistant assessor, shall be appointed for any ward, the tax commissioner shall designate the property and territory to be assessed by each.

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts conflicting with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 22, 1891.
