shall be constructed as aforesaid, within three months after said owners, occupants or persons having charge of such dam, shall have been notified in writing by the board of fish commissioners of the state of Wisconsin. No person or corporation shall be required to build or construct any fishway under the provisions of this act, the cost of which shall exceed three hundred dollars, including royalty if patent fishways are used.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 346.

AN ACT to provide for the expense of the Sturgeon Bay canal investigating committee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Secretary of state to audit bill of and draw warrant for expenses of, legislative investigating committee.

SECTION 1. The secretary of state is hereby authorized and directed to audit the accounts of the thorized and directed to investigate the affairs of the Sturgeon Bay and Lake Michigan Ship Canal and Harbor company, for expenses incurred by such investigation, and to draw his warrant upon the state treasurer therefor, payable to the order of the chairman of said committee.

Appropriation.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated a sum sufficient for the purpose of this act.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
