CHAPTER 36.

AN ACT to amend chapter 159, laws of 1885, entitled "An act to revise, codify and amend chapter 278, laws of 1874, entitled 'An act to incorporate the city of Shawano,'" and the several acts amendatory thereof.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amends chapter 4, laws of 1885.

Justices of the peace, their jurisdiction.

Section 1. Section 15 of chapter 4, of chapter 159, laws of 1885, is hereby amended by adding thereto the words, "and they may hold their respective offices in any part or portion of said city of Shawano; provided, that no two of them shall hold their offices in the same room," so that said section, when amended, shall read as follows: Section 15. The justices of the peace elected under this act shall have the same jurisdiction, and perform all duties of justices of the peace, and shall qualify in the same manner as provided by the general laws of this state, except that the official bonds shall be approved by a majority of the common council; and they may hold their respective offices in any part or portion of said city of Shawano; provided, that no two of them shall hold their offices in the same room.

SECTION 2. This act shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication.
