Use of library.

SECTION 3. All blind citizens of the state shall have the privilege of using this library, under such rules and regulations as the superintendent of the school for the blind shall deem necessary for the safety and preservation of the library.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 291.

AN ACT to change the boundaries of the towns in Forest county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Attaches territory to Crandon.

SECTION 1. The west half of township thirtyseven north, of range thirteen east, is hereby detached from the town of Gagen, and attached to the town of Crandon.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 19, 1893.
