## CHAPTER 158.

AN ACT relating to the collection of taxes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

City paying rental for water supply, may retain certain taxes. SECTION 1. Any city in this state paying rental for a water supply to any person, company or corporation owning or furnishing the same, may retain all taxes assessed and levied against any such person, company or corporation and due and collectible by said city out of any of such rentals.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 159.

AN ACT for the preservation of fish in Wilson and Mill creeks, in Jackson county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Close term for fishing in Wilson and Mill Creeks. SECTION 1. No person or persons shall be allowed to fish for, take or catch or kill, with any device whatever, any fish in the streams known as Wilson valley creek and Mill creek, or their tributaries, in the town of Melrose in the county of Jackson, in this state, for a period of two years from the fifteenth day of April, 1857, nor shall any person or persons sell or offer to
