CHAPTER 180.

AN ACT to amend chapter 187, laws of Wisconsin for the year 1885, relating to bridges, as amended by chapter 508, of the laws of Wisconsin for the year 1889.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

City or village authorized to vote aid for bridges.

SECTION 1. Chapter 187, laws of Wisconsin for the year 1885, relating to bridges, as amended by chapter 508, of the laws of Wisconsin for the year 1889, is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following: Provided further, that any city or village next adjoining any such town may at any annual or special election called for that purpose, vote to aid said town in the repair or construction of such bridge or bridges.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 181.

AN ACT to amend sections 2, 4, 43 and 55, of chapter 292, of the laws of 1893, relating to the Wisconsin National Guard.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2, of chapter 292, of the laws of 1893, is hereby amended by striking
