# CHAPTER 192.

### AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money therein mentioned to James Allen.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation to James Allen for lands illegally sold by the state.

There is hereby appropriated to SECTION 1. James Allen out of any money in the treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of seventyeight dollars and twenty-three cents, the same being the amount paid by him to the state treasurer, September 2, 1887, as the purchase price for the east half of the northeast quarter of section twenty-nine in township eighteen north, of range twenty-one east. The state having no title to said lands, the same having been sold by the state to one John Mueller, February 5, 1870. The purpose of this act is to refund to said James Allen the money paid into the treasury aforesaid; provided, that said money shall not be paid to James Allen except upon a receipt for the same signed by James Allen and Jacob A. Williams, and that the money so paid shall be paid out of the drainage fund.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
