## CHAPTER 209.

AN ACT to authorize the Farmers' Mutual Fire Insurance Company of the town of Union, Rock county, Wisconsin, to file articles of incorporation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Farmers' Mutual Fire Ins. Co. may file articles of incorporation.

SECTION 1. The Farmers' Mutual Fire Insurance Company of the town of Union, Rock. county, Wisconsin, is hereby authorized and empowered to file articles of incorporation under section 1927, annotated statutes of Wisconsin, and such articles of incorporation when so filed shall have the same force and effect as if they had been filed on the eleventh day of June, A. D. 1876, under and by virtue of the provisions of chapter 103, of the general laws of 1872; and all acts done by said insurance company that would have been legal had the said articles of incorporation been filed on the eleventh day of June, A. D. 1876, under and by virtue of the provisions of chapter 103, of the general laws of 1872, are hereby legalized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
