## CHAPTER 210.

AN ACT to authorize John E. McMullen, his heirs, associates and assigns to build and maintain a dam across the Big Eau Plaine river on any lands that he or they may own or control in township twenty-nine north, of range two east, in Marathon county, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. John E. McMullen, his heirs, as-Authorized to sociates and assigns are hereby authorized to build and maintain a dam across the Big Eau Plaine river on any lands that he or they may own or control in township twenty-nine north, of range two east, in Marathon county, Wisconsin. Such dam may be used for driving, booming, storing, or rafting of logs and lumber, and the water power thereby created for hydraulic and manufacturing purposes.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and

publication.
