CHAPTER 301.

AN ACT to appropriate money to pay for the copies of Sanborn and Berryman's annotated statutes furnished this legislature pursuant to joint resolution number three senate.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation to pay for annotated statutes furnished the legislature. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated a sum sufficient to pay for the copies of Sanborn and Berryman's annotated statutes furnished this legislature by the superintendent of public property pursuant to joint resolution number three senate. The account for said statutes shall be audited by the secretary of state, on its approval by said superintendent, provided that the cost thereof shall not exceed four dollars and fifty cents per volume.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and

publication.
