CHAPTER 305.

AN ACT to provide compensation for the officiating chaplains of the senate and assembly for the session of 1895.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation to the officiating clergymen of the legislature.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to each and every clergyman who has or may hereafter officiate as chaplain of the senate and assembly the sum of fifteen dollars for each week of such service during the session of the legislature for the year 1895. The payment shall be made upon the certificates of the chief clerks of the senate and assembly showing the amount to which each such chaplain is entitled.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
