CHAPTER 35.

AN ACT to amend section 1, of chapter 259, laws of 1893, entitled, "An act to provide county and city depositories and regulate the deposit of public moneys therein."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

County and city depositories, law amended. SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 259, of the laws of 1893, entitled, "An act to provide county and city depositories and regulate the deposit of public moneys therein," is hereby amended by striking out the word "or" in the first line of said section and inserting a comma after the word "banks," in the first line of said section, and by inserting after the word "institutions" in the second line of said section 1, the words "or trust company organized and doing business under the laws of the state of Wisconsin," so that said section 1, of chapter 259, of the laws of 1893 as amended shall read as follows: Section 1. Any bank, banks, banking institutions, or trust company organized and doing business under the laws of the state of Wisconsin, which shall be approved by the board of supervisors of any county in this state, may, upon filing bonds as hereinafter provided, and upon compliance with all other requirements of law, become a county depository.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
