CHAPTER 77.

AN ACT to authorize Lewis M. Alexander, his associates and assigns, to build and maintain a dam across the Wisconsin river, on section thirty-six, in township twenty-two north, of range five east, in Wood county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senage and assembly, do enact or follows:

Authorized to build and construct a dam.

SECTION 1. Lewis M. Alexander, his associates and assigns, are hereby authorized to build and maintain a dam across the Wisconsin river at any point in section thirty-six, in township twenty-two north, of range five east, not exceeding sixteen feet in height, and to use the water of said river for propelling any kind of machinery he now has or may hereafter see fit to erect, and to sell or lease the right to use said water and water power created by said dam to any person or persons whomsoever; provided, said dam shall be so constructed as not to obstruct the running of lumber, logs or timber down said river; and, provided, further, a slide shall be constructed in said dam at least two feet below the general height thereof and at least forty feet in width, and in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 2. The right to repeal or amend

this act is hereby reserved.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
