## CHAPTER 78.

## AN ACT to legalize the acts of the Salem Mound Cemetery association.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Whereas, certain persons did, Cemetery ason the eighteenth day of September, 1858, in to record the minutes of the town of Salem, in the county of Kenosha, meeting. attempt to organize a cemetery association to be known as the Salem Mound Cemetery association, but failed to record the minutes of the meeting and plat of the grounds, as required by law; and,

Whereas, Said association under the above official acts of name, in said town and county, has ever since officers legalcontinued to act as a cemetery association duly organized; therefore, it is hereby declared that all official acts of the officers of the above named association shall be valid and binding in all respects, as if said association had complied with the law relating to the organization of cemetery societies in every particular.

SECTION 2. This act shall be recorded at the To be recorded expense of the above named association, in the of the associa-expense of the presistor of decide in the needed tion. office of the register of deeds, in the record book kept by him for recording the certificates of the organization of cemetery associations, and shall in every instance be taken as complete evidence of the legal organization of said association on the eighteenth day of September, 1858.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
