CHAPTER 80.

AN ACT relating to an act to authorize Jacob Searls, A. E. Bennett and James Gaynor to connect by a canal Hemlock creek with Cranberry creek in Wood county; and amendatory of section 2, of chapter 265, of the laws of 1893.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2, of chapter 265, of the authorized to laws of 1893, is hereby amended by striking out the word "twenty-two" in the seventh line of said section and inserting in lieu thereof the word "twenty-one," so that said section when amended shall read as follows: Section 2. The head of said canal shall be located on Hemlock creek at some convenient point on section thirty-three in township twenty-three north, of range four east, and shall extend thence southerly over the most feasible route to a point on section ten in township twenty-one north, of range four east, where Cranberry creek crosses the right of way of the Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul railway.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
