be for comparison with the certified statement named in section 2, of this act. The result of analysis of the sample or samples so procured shall be reported to the person or persons requesting the analysis, and shall also be published in a report or bulletin within a reasonable time.

SECTION 7. It shall be the duty of the di-Prosecutions, by whom con-rector of the Wisconsin Agricultural Experi-ducted. ment station to enforce the provisions of this act, and to prosecute or cause to be prosecuted any party or parties violating the same.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after December 1st, 1895.

CHAPTER 88.

AN ACT relating to the salary of the deputy railroad commissioner and reenacting chapter 281, of the laws of Wisconsin for the year 1889.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in scnate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 281, of the laws of Wis-Affecting the consin for the year 1889, entitled, "An act re-deputy railroad commissioner." lating to the salary of the deputy railroad commissioner and appropriating a certain sum of money therefor," is hereby reenacted as the law of this state notwithstanding the provisions contained in chapter 31, of the laws of 1895, entitled, "An act to amend chapter 43, of the laws of 1883, entitled, 'An act in relation to the departments of insurance and railroads."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
