## JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 11.

Authorizing the railroad commissioner to take action in certain cases.

Resolved that the railroad commissioner be and is hereby authorized to investigate the conditions at such places as may enter a complaint to him, as to inadequate station facility, and if in his opinion, such station or stations ought to be opened and maintained, he shall notify such railroad company complained of as to his decision in the matter, and direct that such station be opened and maintained. He shall report at the next session of the legislature, the failure of any railroad company to do so.
