CHAPTER 127.

AN ACT to amend section 16, of chapter 6, of the laws of 1895, entitled, "An act to establish a police court in the city of Milwaukee."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 16, of chapter 6, of the Regardin's ap-laws of the state of Wisconsin of 1895, is police court. bereby amended by inserting after the word "Milwaukee" at the end of the first sentence in said section 16, the following additional sentence: "And an appeal may in like manner be taken by the city of Milwaukee in cases to recover a penalty for the violation of a city ordinance where the judgment of the court shall be pronounced in favor of the defendant."

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publi-

cation.
