CHAPTER 130.

AN ACT to authorize the Citizens' State Bank of Whitewater to reduce its capital stock from seventy-five thousand dollars to fifty thousand dollars.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Capital stock reduced to \$10,000.

SECTION 1. The Citizens' State Bank, located and doing business in the city of Whitewater, Walworth county, and state of Wisconsin, is hereby authorized to reduce its capital stock from seventy-five thousand dollars to fifty thousand dollars.
