CHAPTER 151.

AN ACT to amend chapter 224, of the laws of 1895, relating to terms of court of the fifteenth judicial circuit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Dates for terms of court in the fifteenth judicial circuit.

Chapter 224, of the laws of 1895, SECTION 1. is hereby amended to read as follows: Section 1. The several terms of the circuit court of the fifteenth judicial circuit shall be held as follows: In the county of Ashland, on the first Monday of January, the fourth Monday of April and the first Monday of September; in the county of Bayfield, on the first Monday of June and the third Monday of October; in the county of Iron, on the third Monday of June and the second Monday of November; in the county of Price, on third Monday of May, and the fourth Monday of November; in the county of Sawyer, on the third Monday of April, and the first Monday of December; and in the county of Taylor, on the first Wednesday after the first Tuesday of April. and on the first Monday of October.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
