## CHAPTER 189.

AN ACT relating to the disposition of fines in certain cases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Act allowing half the fines to go to informers re-- pealed. SECTION 1. Section 9, chapter 165, laws of 1891; section 6, chapter 228, laws of 1893; section 6, chapter 257, laws of 1895; section 5, chapter 40, laws of 1881, providing that one-half of fines collected shall go to informers, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
