SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 232.

AN ACT to amend chapter 256, of the laws of 1891, entitled, "an act to amend chapter 373, of the laws of 1889," entitled "an act to amend chapter 22, of the laws of 1887," entitled "an act to amend chapter 258, of the laws of 1883," entitled, "an act to provide for the annual publication of a railroad map, and appropriating moneys therefor."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 256, of the laws of 1891, is hereby amended by striking out the words "fifteen thousand" where they occur in the fifth line of said section, and substituting therefor the words "seventeen thousand;" by striking out the words "three thousand" where they occur in the tenth line of said section, and substituting therefor the words "four thousand three hundred and thirty;" by striking out the words "four thousand" where they occur in the

thirteenth line of said section, and substituting therefor the words "four thousand six hundred and seventy;" by striking out the words "one thousand" where they occur in the fifteenth line of said section, and substituting therefor the words "one thousand six hundred and seventy;" so that said section when so amended shall read as follows: Section 1. There shall be published biennially, under the supervision of the railroad commissioner, seventeen thousand copies of the railroad map of Wisconsin, of which eight thousand copies shall be mounted on muslin and provided with rollers, to be distributed by the state superintendent of public instruction among the schools of the state; four thousand three hundred and thirty copies shall be likewise mounted on muslin and provided with rollers, to be apportioned and delivered to the members of the legislature; four thousand six hundred and seventy copies, of which three thousand shall be unmounted and one thousand six hundred and seventy likewise mounted on muslin and provided with rollers, to be distributed by the railroad commissioner; and a sum of money sufficient to carry out the provisions of this act is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
