CHAPTER 234.

AN ACT to authorize Maitland H. Wilcox to erect, maintain and keep a dam across a spring brook in Dunn county, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in scrate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Maitland H. Wilcox, his associ-Relating to a ates, heirs and assigns are hereby authorized spring brook, to erect, maintain and keep a dam not more than five feet high, across a spring brook, a tributary of Gilbert Creek, in Dunn county, Wisconsin, on the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section twenty-six, in township twenty-eight, north, of range fourteen, west, for the purpose of hatching, propagating and raising fish; provided, however, that no fishway shall be required in said dam.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
