CHAPTER 252.

AN ACT authorizing the state historical society to sell and convey certain real estate.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Giving the state historical society the right to sell and convey real estate.

SECTION 1. The state historical society of Wisconsin, is hereby authorized to sell for such price, and upon conditions as its finance committee may deem best for the interests of said society, and to convey real estate acquired by it, by gift or bequest, or through the foreclosure of any mortgage, now or hereafter owned by the society.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 253.

AN ACT to repeal chapter 337, laws of Wisconsin, 1895, relating to fishways in dams.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Fishways act repealed.

SECTION 1. Chapter 337, of the laws of Wisconsin, 1895, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
