CHAPTER 272.

AN ACT to authorize William Snyder, his heirs or assigns, to construct and maintain a dock or pier in the waters of Green Bay, in Door county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authority granted to construct a pier in waters of Green Bay,

SECTION 1. William Snyder, his heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to build, construct and maintain a dock or pier, in the waters of Green Bay, in front of, and appurtenant to lot three, section eighteen, in township twenty-eight north, of range twenty-seven east, in Door county, Wisconsin.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

AN ACT to regulate the sale of impure ice.
