CHAPTER 292.

AN ACT to appropriate to the persons therein named a sum of money for expenses incurred in serving on apportionment committee, as provided in joint resolution 20, A., of 1895.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

\$100 appropriated to each member of the apportionment committee.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for expenses incurred in serving on apportionment committee, as provided by joint resolution No. 20, A., of 1895, to I_{α} W. Thayer, J. H. Stout, Wm. Kennedy, Jay G. Lamberson, N. B. Treat, Frank A. Anson, Cyrus Yawkey, John G. Conway and Herman Schellenberg, the sum of one hundred dollars each.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
