county, Wisconsin, are hereby legalized and made as valid as the same would have been had the said officers been duly and regularly elected annually at a regular meeting of the members of said association.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 321.

AN ACT to amend chapter 315, laws of 1885, entitled, "An act in relation to the instruction of deaf mutes in incorporated cities and villages, and making an appropriation therefor."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3, of chapter 315, laws of Act amended. 1885, as amended by section 1, of chapter 305, laws of 1893, is hereby amended by striking out the words "one hundred and twenty-five" where they appear in said section, and inserting in lieu thereof, the words "one hundred and fifty."

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts that contravene the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
