## CHAPTER 63.

AN ACT relating to evidence in certain cases.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The transcribed records of Iron county, which have been transcribed from the original records of other counties, of which the territory now comprising said Iron county was formerly a part, under and by direction of the county board of Iron county; and certified to under the hand and official seal of the

officer having the custody of such original records, shall be received in all courts in this state, as prima facie evidence of the matters therein contained, in the same manner as now provided by law for the reception of record evidence, notwithstanding any defects in said certificate, either as to form or omission therefrom of matter or facts required by law to be stated.

SECTION 2. One such certificate to each volume of records, or other documents so transcribed, shall be deemed sufficient. One certificate sufficient.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 64.

AN ACT to authorize the Kickapoo Valley Gun Club to construct and maintain a private bridge across the Kickapoo river in Crawford county, on the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section number seven, in township number seven north, of range number four west.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The Kickapoo Valley Gun Club, in the county of Crawford and state of Wisconsin, its successors and assigns, is hereby authorized and empowered to construct and maintain a private bridge across the Kickapoo river in said county, on the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section seven in township Kickapoo Valley gun club authorized to construct a bridge.
