## CHAPTER 96.

## AN ACT relating to cemeteries.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Title to cemetery grounds, to be conveyed.

SECTION 1. The town of Harmony, Rock county, Wisconsin, by resolution of the supervisors of said town, may convey by good and sufficient deed of conveyance all of the right, title and interest of said town in and to the cemetery grounds used as the town cemetery, and situate on the west side of the west half of the northwest quarter of section twenty-five (25), town three (3) north, range thirteen (13) east, to the cemetery association of said town, the corporate name of which is "Mt. Zion Cemetery Association."

Cemetery association authorized to receive the grounds.

SECTION 2. The Cemetery association of the town of Harmony, Rock county, Wisconsin, the corporate name of which is "Mt. Zion Cemetery Association," is hereby authorized and empowered to receive, take and hold the title to the cemetery grounds used as the town cemetery in the said town of Harmony, mentioned in the first section of this act, and hereafter have full and exclusive care, control and management of the same.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
