keepers, clerks and employes, and that such committee be further instructed to report in what offices, if any, the clerical force should creased or diminished, and what change, if any, should be made in the compensation, so as to fix the salaries paid to such assistants, book-keepers, clerks and employes in the several departments, and that such committee be authorized to report a bill classifying such employes and designating the salaries each one shall receive as compensation for their services, correcting all inequalities in the present compensation received, if any such inequality is found to exist.

JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 3.

Resolved, by the senate, the assembly concurring, that bill No. 33, S., entitled, "A bill to revise the general statutes," be referred to a joint special committee, composed of such persons as the judiciary committees may agree upon; that such committee, when so appointed, shall be furnished, by the superintendent of public property, with such laws, statutes and other books as it may require; that it shall be the duty of such committee to embody in their proper places in said bill such laws as may be enacted at this session, as ought to form a part of the proposed statutes, and that it may have such printing done as may be necessary for the performance of its duties.
