CHAPTER 101.

AN ACT to amend section 1955c under sub-head "beneficiary" of chapter 89 of the Wisconsin statutes of 1898.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Policy holder may change beneficiary without consent of latter. SECTION 1. Section 1955c of chapter 89 of the Wisconsin statutes of 1898, is hereby repealed, and the following substituted in place thereof: Beneficiary. Section 1955c. Any member of such society, order or association may name as his beneficiary any person or persons designated by the laws of such society, order or association or if the laws thereof permit, his insurance may be made payable to his estate. Any member may change the beneficiary named in his certificate or policy without the consent of such beneficiary, by complying with the by-laws of the society, order or association which issued the same.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
