CHAPTER 123.

AN ACT to increase the appropriation to the commissioners of fisheries, to enable them to procure transportation for employes, fish, fry, spawn, car and materials.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation SECTION 1. To enable the commissioners of fisherics to procure transportation for their employes, fish, car, spawn and fry in the distribution of the same throughout the state, there is hereby appropriated an addition of six thousand dollars annually to their appropriation under existing laws.

> SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
