## **CHAPTER 148.**

# AN ACT relating to superintendents of city schools.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Certificates may be issued to teach certain branches.

:

SECTION 1. Any city superintendent of schools may issue certificates to teachers of special branches, qualifying them to teach such branches in the schools under his supervision, after such examination as to their fitness to teach such branches as may be provided by the school board and approved by the state superintendent.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
