CHAPTER 151.

AN ACT relating to the appointment and salaries of under sheriff and deputy sheriffs in all counties in this state having a population of more than one hundred thousand.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The sheriff of every county having a population of more than one hundred thousand according to the last national census is hereby authorized to appoint one under sheriff whose salary shall be one thousand eight hundred dollars per annum, to be paid monthly out of the treasury of said county; and eighteen deputy sheriffs, of whom one shall act as clerk in the sheriff's office; the said deputy sheriffs shall receive a salary of one thousand dollars per annum, excepting the one acting as clerk in the sheriff's office, who shall receive fifteen hundred dollars per annum. One of such deputies shall be assigned to the office of the district attorney of said county, and shall be subject to the orders of the district attorney. The salaries of the said eighteen deputy sheriffs, shall be paid

monthly out of the treasury of said county, and the salaries so paid to said under sheriff and said deputy sheriffs shall be in lieu of all fees per diem and other emoluments of whatever kind and nature heretofore allowed by law.

SECTION 2. In all counties where the sheriff of said county has made his appointments in accordance with the provisions of this act, in the year 1899, said appointments are hereby declared legal, the same as if made after the passage of this act, and all under sheriffs and deputy sheriffs so heretofore appointed, shall be paid as fixed herein from the date of their appointment and their acts are hereby legalized.

SECTION 3. All acts or parts of acts in conflict with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 152.

AN ACT authorizing the appointment of assistant factory inspectors and to make an appropriation therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Six assistant

SECTION 1. The commissioner of labor and industrial statistics shall have power to appoint six suitable persons as assistant factory inspectors who shall perform their duties under his direction and who may be removed by him for cause.
