CHAPTER 307.

AN ACT to amend section 1816b, and subdivision 5 of section 4222 of the Wisconsin statutes, relating to the commencement of civil actions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

When notice
need not be
served

SECTION 1. Section 1816b, and subdivision 5 of section 4222 of the statutes are hereby amended by adding to the end of each thereof the words “when an action shall be brought and a complaint actually served therein within one year after the happening of the event causing such damages, the notice herein provided for need not be served.”

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
