rized company without having said policy of reinsurance signed by a local agent in this state.

CHAPTER 345.

AN ACT to amend chapter 367 of the laws of 1897, relating to the estimating, appraising and sale of state lands.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2, of chapter 367 of the Sale of lands. laws of 1897, is hereby amended by striking out the following words in lines twelve and thirteen thereof, "and all lands withdrawn from market at Spooner, Washburn county."

SECTION 2. Section 6 of said act, is hereby Examination of land. amended so as to read as follows: Section 6. All other lands heretofore approved or patented to the state, by the United States, shall be withdrawn from public sale; all such lands and all lands which may hereafter be selected by the state or approved or patented to the state by the United States, shall be examined by the persons duly appointed as provided by section 3 of this act, and appraised as hereinbefore provided, and shall be offered for sale at such times and places as is deemed for the best interest of the state.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
