Appropriation payable to clerk of district.

SECTION 3. The said sum of six hundred and twenty-nine dollars and eleven cents, shall be paid to A. N. Bort, clerk of said school district, or to his successor in office, by the state treasurer, as soon as this act shall take effect and be in force.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 61.

AN ACT to amend chapter 40a, of the revised statutes of the state of Wisconsin, relating to bicycles.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Licensing power removed from common council.

SECTION 1. Sub-division number 66, of section 925-52 of chapter 40a, of the revised statutes of the state of Wisconsin is hereby amended by striking therefrom the word "license" where it occurs in the first line thereof, so that when so amended such sub-division shall read as follows: 66. To regulate bicycles and the use thereof upon the streets and public places, and provide for the use of bells and lights thereon.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
