CHAPTER 12.

AN ACT to amend section 13, chapter 241, of the laws of Wisconsin for the year 1893, fixing the salary of the clerk of the municipal court for the city and county of Ashland.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Clerk's salary increased to \$900. Section 1. Section 13 of chapter 241 of the laws of Wisconsin, passed in the year 1893, is amended by striking out the word "six," where it occurs in the fifth line of said section between the words "of" and "hundred," and inserting in lieu thereof the word "nine." so that said section when so amended shall read as follows: The judge for his services in criminal matters shall receive, in addition to the compensation hereinbefore provided, a salary of sixteen hun-
